

Meet Me on Market **Artist Agreement** 2021

The event formerly known as Spring Fling will now feature juried art from all arrays, such as music, live art, as well as demonstrational/interactive art.

LOCATION- The central location for the festival is the downtown area of Dayton. Absolutely no motorized vehicles will be allowed to remain in the vending area or the parking spaces on the sides of Market Street. This is an outdoor event so please prepare accordingly.

FOOD TRUCK & CUNLINARY VENDORS- The food TRUCK vendors will be located throughout Market St. Culinary vendors on 2nd Avenue. Food truck vendors will receive specific agreement upon application and approval. The set-up area is on the street and therefore you must be prepared to set up on the pavement and ALL CULINARY (Non-Food Truck) VENDORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE GROUND COVER AND FIRE EXTINGUISHERS. The ground cover can be roofing felt, or a type of mat. You will be covering the ground area of the entire booth. (NO STAKES ALLOWED ON PAVEMENT). All (Food Truck & Culinary) must include detailed description of the food/menu you offer, at time of application. The cost for FOOD TRUCK SPACE/ CULINARY SPACE is **\$100** for **NON-MainStreet Dayton Members** and **\$50** for **Mainstreet Dayton Members**. The Tennessee Department of Health will be on site for inspection Saturday morning.

DEMONSTRATIONAL/LIVE ARTISTS- . There will be NO food sales in any other area than designated for food vendors. A copy of your liability insurance must be submitted with your application. Vendors will be required to secure their tents, tables, etc. with weights. You must stay within your allotted area.

- **\$50 (NON-MainStreet Dayton Member and \$25 for MainStreet Members)** for a 12x12 space with electricity provided (please indicate on the application). Please note you are renting "real estate". You MUST provide your own tables, chairs, tent, extension cords, etc. If additional space is needed, you will be required to purchase it.

RULES & REGULATIONS-

- No alcoholic beverages allowed; for sale or personal use. No selling of food or drinks in the art vending area.
- Meet Me on Market & MainStreet Dayton Coordinators reserve the right to remove any vendors from their space for not following the rules, regulations, terms and conditions set forth in this document and the acceptance packet.
- You must stay within your assigned space.
- You may not lower your prices for "end of day" sales. You are permitted to adjust your price to match other vendors, but no undercutting in prices.
- No giving away food or drinks (sodas) in a art vendor booth.
- Must provide a cell phone # and email address for communication purposes (see application).
- The Festival only accepts one vendor of each type of artistic form. We will not duplicate, so it is first come/first served.
- For Artists – pieces to be sold must be made by the artist and be appropriate for a family event.
- Artists must send 3 photos of your work. If you want the photos returned, please provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
- All artwork must be the original, handcrafted work of the displaying artist.
- Buy/Sell vendors are strictly prohibited. All items must be the original work of the artist and not mass-produced.
- Exhibitors agree to allow MainStreet Dayton to use photos in promotions.
- Vendor Cancellation – other than a medical emergency, with written documentation from your physician, there is no refund. There will be a refund if covid related.

ACCEPTANCE- Upon acceptance, you will receive a confirmation EMAIL. If you are not accepted you will be notified and your check will be returned. Confirmation packets will be sent between April 2nd-5th via EMAIL. The confirmation packet will include a parking pass with your booth number, a map of the vending area, and instructions on setup time.
